The CBSE has decided to implement the uniform system of assessment and examination pattern for Classes VI to VIII.

The assessment structure and examination for classes VI to VIII has been prepared in view of the provisions of RTE-Act 2009 and comprises of two terms i.e. Term-1 and 2 as explained below:
